## IIWCC OVERVIEW

The International Interprofessional Wound Care Course (IIWCC) is designed for wound care specialists with some wound care education and experience: physicians, nurses, and other allied health professionals in the wound care field and related industry.

The IIWCC is a 9-to-12-month course objective is to provide a comprehensive educational experience for wound care specialists and to translate new knowledge into practice.

Participants will obtain a Certificate of Completion from Queen's University upon successful completion of:

- Two mandatory Educational Sessions (3 days each)
- Fourteen self-study modules (9 required to complete: 5 faculty chosen and 4 student chosen)
- A selective related to the student's day-to-day activities that is presented to the class and faculty along with a submitted written report -demonstrates the translation of evidence to practice setting.
- Four Skills Workshops including 3 virtual platform sessions with faculty between educational sessions.


