IIWCC OVERVIEW

The International Interprofessional Wound Care Course (IIWCC) is designed for wound care specialists with some wound care education and experience: physicians, nurses, and other health professionals in the wound care field related industry.

The IIWCC is a 12-month course, offered in partnership with the University of Toronto. The objective is to provide a comprehensive educational experience for wound care specialists and to translate new knowledge into practice.

- Two mandatory Educational Sessions
- Fourteen self-study modules (9 required to complete 5 faculty chosen and 4 student chosen)
- A selective related to student,s day to day activities is presented to the class and faculty along with a submitted written report-demonstrated translation of evidence to practice setting.
- Skills Workshops including 3 virtual platform sessions with faculty between educational sessions
- Virtual Skills sessions 10 hours spread between the 10 educational sessions for skills acquisition.
